

General Release



By signing below and in exchange for the opportunity to participate in a firearms training event, the undersigned (“Participant”) indicates that she or he has carefully read and understands this General Release, and acknowledges and agrees to the following items, on behalf of Participant and her or his heirs, guardians, representatives, successors and assigns.

(a) Participant is at least 18 years of age, mentally competent and medically able to agree to the terms of this General Release. To the extent Participant is a minor, the parent or guardian listed below gives Participant permission to participate in a training event under the conditions stated within and signs on behalf of Participant. The individual signing below gives this General Release freely and knowingly with full understanding of its content and effect.

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(b) Participant is legally permitted to possess and use firearms and other related equipment (“Firearms”), whether as part of a firearms training event or otherwise, and is capable of using Firearms safely. Participant is responsible for determining the requirements of all applicable laws as they may relate to ownership, possession and use of firearms, and remaining in compliance with such requirements. Participant will follow the policies, procedures and rules of the trainer, including the policies, procedures and rules of the venue where the training event takes place. The trainers reserve the right to revoke Participant’s right to participate in a training event at any time for any reason.

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(c) Participant has made a fully informed decision to participate in firearms training events, understanding that inherent in the nature of such events and the use of Firearms is the potential of serious property damage and physical injury, up to and including death. Participant understands that the use of Firearms may involve risks (unforeseen or otherwise) and that Participant is responsible for her or his own safety and behavior, including but not limited to the use of appropriate personal protective equipment and refraining from the use of substances that may alter Participant’s mental state. Participant is under no obligation to attend or participate in any firearms training event, and is permitted to decline participation or attendance or continued participation or attendance in a training event at any time for any reason.

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(d) Participant waives, releases and forever discharges any rights, claims, demands, or objections which Participant has, or which afterwards may accrue to Participant against Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training; its affiliates, sponsors, partners, or licensees; or any of its officers, directors, employees, facilitators, volunteers, agents, representatives, assigns or successors (past or present. including for any physical injury, death or property damage, in connection with Participant’s participation in a firearms training event, regardless of the cause of such rights, claims, demands, or objections. Participant understands that this General Release is intended to discharge, release and waive any and all claims, damages, and liabilities arising from her or his

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participation in a firearms training event, even if such claims arise by the negligence of Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training. Participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training from and against any claims, damages, and liabilities that Participant had or may have for personal injury, death, or property damage arising in any way from participation in a training event.

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(e) Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training may designate personnel to capture photographs and recordings (either audio or visual) of Participant during a firearm training event. Participant consents to the use of the photographs and recordings for unlimited time and will remain in my possession in perpetuity. These photographs and recordings are required as documentation that training has taken place, as well as proof that some level of performance was attempted and/or achieved. These photographs and recordings will only be released to appropriate authorities via subpoena. Participant waives the right to inspect or approve the finished materials in which the photographs and recordings may be exhibited, published or distributed. All photographs and recordings are owned Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training and may register any copyrights or other intellectual property rights in the photographs and recordings. Participant waives all rights or claims in any photographs and recordings using Participant's name, photograph, voice persona or likeness contained in the photographs and recordings. Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training are only responsible for photographs and recordings captured by its designated personnel; other participants in League events are responsible for obtaining their own permissions and Participant understand that Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training have no control over these other participants.

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(f) If any provision of this General Release is deemed invalid or unenforceable, it will not invalidate the remaining provisions of this General Release. Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training's failure to exercise any of its rights under this General Release does not prevent it from exercising such rights at a later date. This General Release contains the full and complete understanding of the instructors and Participant with regard to its subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, cannot be modified except in writing signed by both Participant and Jeff Miller and/or Crossroads Firearms Training, and is governed in accordance with the laws of Indiana, without regard to its conflict or choice of law provisions. This General Release will continue in effect even after termination of Participant's participation in the firearms training class. An electronic or facsimile signature will have the same force and effect as an original, non-facsimile signature.

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(g) Pregnant women are encouraged to discuss their participation in this course with their physicians prior to this event. Discuss the effects of exposure to loud sounds and airborne lead

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particulate. Any students that are pregnant or nursing an infant should not handle any chemicals, lubricants, or solvents unless they have discussed doing so with their physician.
